Description of the organisation

Şirinyer Anadolu Lisesi (ŞAL) is a public high school of general studies with 900 students 14-18 years old and 65 teachers. The studies last four years at the end of which the students take entry exams for the university. The subjects that are taught are: Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Turkish Language and Literature, History, Geography, Philosophy, English, French, Human Rights and Democracy, Art, Music and PE. At the same time the students are involved in various areas such as science fair, art exhibitions, sports competitions. They have won many prizes with their theatrical and sport teams.
