Description of the organisation

YAŞAR UNIVERSITY – TURKEY

Established in 2001 in İzmir –Turkey, Yasar University has quickly become an ideal environment for research, personal development and learning by its 9 faculties (Law, Economics and Administrative Sciences, Engineering, Communication, Art and Design, Science and Letters, Architecture, Business and Humanities), 2 graduate schools, vocational school, EU Research Centre, Open and Distance Learning Centre, Knowledge & Technology Transfer Office and Continuing Education Centre.

Yasar university serves 9403 students in total including 1269 associate degree students, 7294 undergraduates and 840 graduate and postgraduate students. The University has a workforce of 422 academic and 247 administrative staff. Over 62 degree programs are offered in its departments and institutions with English as the medium of instruction for most of the programmes.

Yaşar University has participated in around 85 different EU projects as coordinator and partner, developed around 200 partnership agreements from the EU countries under Erasmus programme and has cooperation with several European countries by its international projects and activities.

Experience of the organization in previous European projects

At Yaşar University, European Union Research Center coordinates the management of all EU funded projects. The center functions to stimulate and strengthen the participation of Yaşar University in European research programmes and projects; develops and participates in EU projects under different EU Programmes, organizes seminars, trainings and certificate programmes on EU specific matters, support the mobilization of students and academics for exchange of knowledge with various EU universities and research centers.

The Center is responsible for the administrative coordination of all EU funded projects at Yaşar University and involved in around 85 EU projects as coordinator or partner by 2017. Also the Center functions as a facilitator between the international and regional partners with its successfully established close relations with the public institutions, NGOs, other universities and research centers.

Yaşar University is one of the most active Turkish universities in Erasmus + projects with its involvement in 8 different KA2 Strategic Partnership projects and 4 ongoing Jean Monnet modules. It is the recipient of Horizon 2020 Programme European Researchers' Night Project for 2016 and 2017, a partner in two FP7 projects on energy efficiency, a Horizon 2020 project on optimization techniques in architecture and holds four Erasmus+ Jean Monnet Modules in the fields of migration, project management, European cultural identity and journalism. Yasar University is also an accredited European Voluntary Service organization and implement EVS projects within the framework of Erasmus+ programme on a regular basis as a sending and coordinating institution.

EU Center also organises several seminars and certificate programmes in regard to current EU issues and project management (PCM) methodology, as well as developing national and international partnerships with other distinguished HEIs and research centers.
